The 5-day International Cultural Immersion Program, is an in-country orientation designed to welcome you to your host country, help you adjust to the academic and cultural differences you might encounter, introduce you to other study abroad students that will be attending ICMS, and expose you to a beautiful and exciting area of Australia.

Educational Session Topics include:

Excursions & Activities include:

Sunrise & Uluru Base Tour Travel to the Uluru sunrise viewing area to watch the first rays of the sun light up Uluru and the Red Centre. After sunrise accompany your Guide on the Mala Walk, which takes you through one of the most important habitation areas for the Aboriginal people. Walk towards Kuniya Piti, a sacred site at Uluru. Board your coach and continue your tour around the circumference of this massive rock

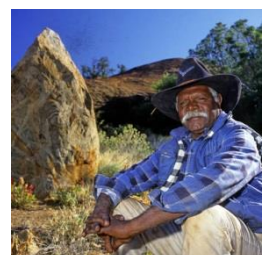
Kata Tjuta Valley of the Winds Walk Kata Tjuta simply translated means 'heads many' and given the 36 steep-sided domes of Kata Tjuta, it is aptly named. This incredible formation of rock domes extends six kilometres into the ground and is the remains of erosion that began more than 500 million years ago. We will walk in the Valley of the Winds. This walk can be a little challenging, but well worth the effort. It takes you down into a timeless haven within the domes through trickling creek beds.

Award Winning Sounds of Silence Experience As the sun sets and darkness falls, listen to the sound of a didgeridoo and join your table for an unforgettable dining experience and an introduction to Aboriginal culture with a traditional dance performance under the outback sky. As the night sky twinkles to life, help yourself to a bush tucker inspired buffet then settle back and listen to our resident star talker decode the southern night sky.
